

Hedgehog

1. Check food and water everyday, refill if needed.
2. Change bedding every 5 days or when needed.
 - A. Take her out and put her in her box or let her walk around.
 - B. Take the food bowl, water bowl, and box out of the cage.
 - C. Empty the bedding into the trash can.
 - D. Place an inch of new bedding (newspaper) in the cage.
 - E. Put some bedding in a corner.
 - F. Place the things back in the cage.

A Little Extra Information.

1. If she is breathing heavy, don't worry, this is normal. She will do this when she is frightened.
2. She will get scared if it is loud in her surrounding environment. So try to be quiet when around her.
3. **If you hold her**, first let her sniff your hands then scoop her up from underneath only touching her soft underbelly. Her spikes will prick you.
4. If she is not moving around during the day that much, don't worry because hedgehogs are nocturnal.
5. Don't stick things in the cage that may be dangerous to her.
6. Have fun taking care of her over break!!
