

# Yellow Throated Plated Lizard

## Feeding

Feed the lizard 6-12 crickets twice a week (usually I give it 8 on Tuesdays and Fridays). REMEMBER TO USE POWDER, (cricket “shake and bake”) shake crickets and powder together in a bag until the crickets are fully covered, pour them into the large food bowl. Make sure that they get into the bowl. Make sure he has water in his bowl. For a treat he eats sweet fruits (bananas etc.) and dark leafy vegetables (kale, romaine lettuce etc.). Obviously do not feed him the whole thing. Cut or tear up a small amount and put it in the small food bowl.

## Cleaning

If there is a lot of waste material in the sand, scoop it up with a fish net. Shake out the sand then dump out the waste at the end of the cleaning.

## Lighting

Have the heating unit, heating lamp, and large light on at all times during the day. Turn off at night. He will get stressed otherwise.

## Other General information

He can bite and is not used to being held yet. The more he is held the more he will become accustomed to it and the easier it will be to hold him.
